



PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT
**FOR THE CONTROL OF TWO-SPOTTED MITE IN BLUEBERRY, RIBES AND
RUBUS CROPS**

PERMIT NUMBER – PER14234

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Products to be used:

ECO-OIL Organic MITICIDE/INSECTICIDE BOTANICAL OIL CONCENTRATE (51403)
Containing: 850 g/L EMULSIFIABLE BOTANICAL OIL as the only active constituent.

Directions for use:

Crop	Insect Pest	Product rate
BLUEBERRIES RUBUS SPP. Including Raspberries and Blackberries RIBES SPP. Including Currants and Gooseberries	TWO-SPOTTED MITE (<i>Tetranychus urticae</i>)	375 – 500 mL / 100 L

Critical Use Comments

- Monitor crops closely and spray when mite activity first appears.
- Apply two sprays 3-5 days apart.
- Apply spray to the point of run-off, ensuring complete coverage of upper and under sides of leaves.
- Use the higher application rate when mite numbers are high.
- If mite reinfestation is observed, repeat application, with a minimum 7 days interval since the last spray treatment.
- DO NOT apply more than three separate sprays to plants within a 4 to 8 week period.

Withholding Period:

Not required when used as directed.

Jurisdiction:

ALL STATES, except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit as their Control-of-Use legislation means that an APVMA permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in that State.

Additional Conditions:

This PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

TO AVOID CROP DAMAGE:

The sensitivity of some species and varieties of the crops to be treated under this permit has not been fully evaluated. It is advisable, therefore, to only treat a small number of plants to ascertain their reaction before treating the whole crop.
