This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows the Permit Holder and any person stipulated below to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

National Parks and Wildlife Service (NPWS) employees and contractors employed by NPWS who are trained and experienced in the use of agricultural chemicals and who are under the direction of the permit holder.

## CONDITIONS OF USE

### Products to be used:

LONTREL HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 31635)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 300 g/L CLORPYRALID PRESENT AS THE TRIISOPROPANOLAMINE SALT as the only active constituent.

LONTREL ADVANCED HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 65587)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 600 g/L CLORPYRALID PRESENT AS THE DIMETHYLAMMONIUM SALT as the only active constituent.

### Directions for Use:

Situation	Weed	Rate
Non-agricultural areas in National Parks and adjoining lands only.	Hawkweeds ( <i>Hieracium</i> spp. and <i>Pilosella</i> spp.)	<u>300 g/L clopyralid products:</u> 5 mL/1 L (spot spray) 5 L/ha (boom spray)  <u>600 g/L clopyralid products:</u> 2.5 mL/1 L (spot spray) 2.5 L/ha (boom spray)

### Critical Use Comments:

- Adhere to ALL product label Restraints, Precautions and Protection statements.
- DO NOT make more than one application per year.
- DO NOT apply when hawkweed is stressed due to periods of extreme cold i.e. winter.
- Treat from rosette stage to early flowering.
- DO NOT apply in areas where there are non-target species of significance known to be present, e.g. endangered corroboree frog.
- Apply as a foliar spot spray using a knapsack or hand/jetting gun.
- Boom spray application is authorised only in situations where off target damage can be minimised to tree species.
- DO NOT broadcast spray over water or allow spray to drift onto non-target areas.

### Withholding period:

Grazing: DO NOT graze or cut for stock food for 7 days after application.

### Jurisdiction:

NSW only.

### Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.
