ROUNDUP BIACTIVE HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 48518)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 360 g/L GLYPHOSATE as the only active constituent.

ONLY USE GLYPHOSATE PRODUCTS REGISTERED FOR USE IN AQUATIC AREAS

AQUATIC AND SEMI-AQUATIC SITUATIONS (non-potable water areas only)	LONGLEAF WILLOW PRIMROSE (<i>Ludwigia longifolia</i>) & WATER PRIMROSE (<i>Ludwigia peruviana</i>)	High volume application: 1 L product / 100 L water Scrape and paint: Apply product undiluted

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply from 1st September to 30th June, or before flowering occurs.
- Repeat applications will be necessary as new germinations occur.
- DO NOT continue spraying if any adverse effects on non-target organisms such as fish or invertebrates are noticed.
- DO NOT spray directly onto water surface and/or non-target species. Refer to label directions to minimise the entry of spray into water.
- Apply spray directly onto the target weed, DO NOT broadcast spray over the water.
- DO NOT apply under weather conditions, or from spraying equipment, that may cause spray drift onto nearby susceptible plants/crops, cropping lands or pastures.

Jurisdiction:

NSW ONLY.

Additional Conditions:

This permit provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on the product label.
