

PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF A REGISTERED AGVET CHEMICAL

PRODUCT FOR CONTROL OF CURCULIO BEETLE AND CUTWORMS IN OLIVE PLANTATIONS

CONDITIONS OF USE

Products to be used:

DOMINEX DUO INSECTICIDE (APVMA No. 53487)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 100 g/L ALPHA-CYPERMETHRIN as the only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

| Crop | Pest | Rate |

| OLIVES | Curculio beetle / Apple weevil (Otiorhynchus cribicollis) Cutworms (Agrotis spp.) | Apply as a butt drench at a rate of 100 mL product per 100 L water. |

Critical Use Comments:

- DO NOT apply more than two applications per season to trees that are of fruit bearing age.
- Drench spray to the butts of trees and the ground around the butt.
- Apply by knapsack sprayer or equivalent using spray volume of 1-2 L water per tree.
- Avoid spraying in conditions excessively wet from irrigation, rain or dew.
- It is recommended that this treatment is NOT be applied to trees older than 2 years to maximise beneficial predators and parasites that may be adversely affected from use of this product.

Withholding Periods:

Harvest: Not required when used as directed.

Grazing: Do not graze or cut treated areas for stock feed.

Jurisdiction:

All states and Territories, except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included under jurisdiction, as their *Control-of-Use* legislation does not require a permit to legalise this off-label use in this state.

Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.

Export of treated produce

Temporary Maximum Residue Limits (TMRLs) have been established to allow treated produce to be used for human consumption. A TMRL has been established for CYPERMETHRIN in OLIVES. MRLs can be found in the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (MRL Standard) Instrument 2019*. MRLs apply only to produce marketed and consumed in Australia. If treated produce is to be exported, residues must not exceed the limits/tolerances of the importing country.
