

PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN REGISTERED AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT

FOR AERIAL CONTROL OF OXEYE DAISY

PERMIT NUMBER - PER14832

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Product to be used:

ACP METSULFURON 600 WG HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 87274) PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 600 g/kg METSULFURON-METHYL as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Situation	Weed	Rate
Environmental Areas	Leucanthemum vulgare Ox-eye daisy	1-2 g/10L

Critical Use Comments:

Apply in a volume of 50 - 80 L/ha using helicopter boom spray calibrated to deliver a COARSE spray to actively growing plants.

DO NOT allow spray to drift onto non target areas

DO NOT spray if rainfall is expected within 4 hours of application

DO NOT apply more than 2 applications per growing season, with a minimum of 3 months between sprays.

SPRAY DRIFT RESTRAINTS

DO NOT apply with spray droplets smaller than a coarse spray droplet size category.

DO NOT apply when wind speed is less than 3 or more than 20 kilometres per hour as measured at the application site.

DO NOT apply during surface temperature inversion conditions at the application site.

Jurisdiction:

NSW ONLY.

Additional Conditions:

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

PERSONS applying pesticides by aircraft in NSW must hold a current NSW pilot (pesticide rating) licence and be employed or engaged by the holder of an aircraft (pesticide applicator) licence
