



**PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT**

**FOR CONTROL OF BLUEBERRY RUST IN BLUEBERRIES**

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. ## CONDITIONS OF USE

### Products to be used:

DRAGON 700 WG FUNGICIDE (68856)

Plus OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 700 g/kg DITHIANON as their only active constituent.

### Directions for Use:

Restraint: DO NOT use in covered or protected situations such as glasshouses, greenhouses or plastic tunnels. Apply only to field grown crops.

Crop	Target Disease	Rate
BLUEBERRIES Field grown ONLY	Blueberry Rust ( <i>Thekospora minima</i> )	50 g product / 100 L

### Critical Use Comments:

- Apply at first sign of rust infection on leaves and continue while weather is conducive to infection.
- Apply as a dilute foliar spray using an airblast, boom sprayer knapsack or micronair mister.
- Use a spray volume sufficient to ensure good coverage and a minimum of 500 L/ha.
- Make a maximum of three (3) applications per season, with minimum 21 day retreatment interval.
- Always add suitable non-ionic spray adjuvant, as per label instructions.
- DO NOT apply if it is likely to rain before spray is dry.
- DO NOT apply to wet crop.
- DO NOT apply under slow drying conditions.

### Withholding Period:

Harvest: DO NOT harvest for 21 DAYS after application

Grazing: DO NOT graze treated crops.

### Jurisdiction:

ALL STATES except VIC.

Note: Victoria has not been included in this permit, as their *Control of Use* legislation does not require a permit to allow this use in that state.

### Additional Conditions:

This PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the DETAILS and CONDITIONS of this permit.
