

PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT

FOR CONTROL OF DOWNY MILDEW IN RUBUS AND RUBUS HYBRIDS

PERMIT NUMBER – PER84973

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

Product to be used:

RIDOMIL GOLD MZ SYSTEMIC & PROTECTIVE FUNGICIDE
PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 40 g/kg METALAXYL-M and
640 g/kg MANCOZEB as its only active constituents.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Plant Disease	Rate
RUBUS AND RUBUS HYBRIDS	Downy mildew (<i>Peronospora</i> spp.)	2.5 kg product / ha Using spray volume of 200-500 L/ha OR 250 g product / 100 L

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply a maximum of two (2) consecutive applications when conditions favour disease development.
- Apply at 14 day intervals from bud burst to pre-flowering, reducing to 10 day intervals from tight cluster to early fruit formation.
- Thorough coverage is essential, spray to the point of run-off.
- Continue the spraying program using non-group 4 fungicides with protective activity.
- Apply a maximum of four (4) foliar spray applications within an annual production cycle.
- Follow ALL restraints on the product label.
- Use in accordance with existing *Fungicide Resistance Management Strategies* and in accordance with best practice.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: DO NOT harvest for 14 DAYS after application.

Jurisdiction:

ALL STATES except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit, as their *Control-of-Use* legislation does not require a permit to legalise this off-label use in that state.

Additional Conditions:

This Permit provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the Details and Conditions of this permit.
