

PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF A REGISTERED AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT FOR CONTROL OF POST-HARVEST ROTS AND MOULDS IN TARO CORMS

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. Products to be used:

TECTO FLOWABLE SC FUNGICIDE (APVMA No. 49910)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 500 g/L THIABENDAZOLE as the only active constituent.

RESTRAINT:

Material must be kept in suspension at all times by continuous agitation. If agitation stops, ensure the mix is resuspended before using.

DO NOT use as a dip for taro leaves.

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply as a post-harvest dip prior to storage.
- Dip for 15 to 30 minutes within 24 hours of digging.
- After treatment, dry in a shaded and well-ventilated area.
- DO NOT apply more than 1 application per crop.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: Not required when used as directed.

Jurisdiction:

All States and Territories, except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit, as their Control-of-Use legislation means a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in that State.

Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.
