### Products to be used:

STERI-MAX BIOCIDES (APVMA No. 59462)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 120 g/L DIDECYL DIMETHYL AMMONIUM CHLORIDE (DDAC) as the only active constituent.

AGRIQUAT DISINFECTANT-SANITIZER-DEODORANT (APVMA No. 41450)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 250 g/L BENZALKONIUM CHLORIDE as the only active constituent.

BACTEX CF SANITISER (APVMA No. 59643)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 100 g/L BENZALKONIUM CHLORIDE as the only active constituent.

### Critical Use Comments:

- Wash down infected or potentially infected items by thoroughly dipping/manually washing equipment or by pressure spray.
- Apply dipping/washing treatment in well-ventilated areas only.
- Minimise the amount of dirt and organic material adhering to equipment by cleaning prior to washing.
- For dipping and washing applications, efficacy may be improved through increased treatment time. A contact time of at least 5 minutes is recommended, where practical, in accordance with the product label uses.
- DO NOT use on personal items that come into direct or indirect contact with the skin (e.g., inside footwear).

### Withholding Period:

Not required when used as directed.

### Jurisdiction:

All States and Territories.

### Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.
