FOR THE CONTROL OF BROADLEAF AND GRASS WEEDS IN FABA BEANS

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. Product to be used:

NUFARM INTERCEPT HERBICIDE [APVMA No. 69353]

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 33 g/L IMAZAMOX and 15 g/L IMAZAPYR as the only active constituents.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
Imidazolinone-tolerant Faba Bean varieties (<i>Vicia faba</i>)	Weeds listed on product label	750 mL/ha

Critical Use Comments:

- To be applied as a foliar spray in a water volume of 100 L/ha. Application to be made via calibrated boom spray.
- Apply early-post emergence at the 4-5 leaves unfolded growth stage. DO NOT apply after BBCH 15.
- Apply to actively growing broadleaf weeds in the 2 to 6 leaf stage.
- Apply to grass weeds up to the 2 tiller stage.
- A maximum of 1 application per crop is to be made.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: Not required when used as directed.

Grazing: Do not graze or cut for stock food for 28 days after application.

Jurisdiction:

All States and Territories.

Additional Conditions:

This PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the DETAILS and CONDITIONS of this permit.
