



**PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF A REGISTERED AGVET CHEMICAL  
PRODUCT FOR CONTROL OF LEAF MINERS IN SPINACH AND SILVERBEET**

## CONDITIONS OF USE

### Product to be used:

CORAGEN INSECTICIDE (APVMA No. 61519)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 200 g/L CHLORANTRANILIPROLE as their only active constituent.

### Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
Spinach and Silverbeet	Leaf miners ( <i>Liriomyza</i> spp.) including:  Cabbage leaf miner ( <i>Liriomyza brassicae</i> )  Vegetable leaf miner ( <i>Liriomyza sativae</i> )  Serpentine leaf miner ( <i>Liriomyza huidobrensis</i> ) (suppression only)	100 mL/ha

### Critical Use Comments:

- Apply as a foliar spray in at least 200 L/ha spray volume using a boom spray.
- DO NOT apply more than 3 application per crop with a minimum re-treatment interval of 7 days.
- Apply no more than 2 consecutive sprays per crop.
- Target sprays against eggs and newly hatched larvae before they become entrenched.
- Use a non-ionic surfactant as a wetter at approved label rates (e.g. Agral Spray Adjuvant @ 25 mL/100L).
- DO NOT use BS1000 or Activator as it may cause crop phytotoxicity.
- DO NOT use on container or hydroponic crops.

### Withholding Period:

Harvest: DO NOT harvest for 3 DAYS after application.

Grazing: DO NOT graze or cut for stock food for 7 days after application.

### Jurisdiction:

All States and Territories except Vic.

(Note: Victoria is not included in this permit because their 'control-of-use' legislation means that a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in Victoria).

### Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.

The holder of the permit must notify the APVMA of new information, including relevant information in accordance with section 161 of the Schedule to the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994, in accordance with the obligation imposed by that section.
