FOR CONTROL OF RUNNING BAMBOO SPECIES IN NON-CROP AREAS,
RIGHTS OF WAY, RESERVES AND BUSHLAND**

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows the Permit Holder and any person stipulated below to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Products to be used:

TASKFORCE WATER SOLUBLE HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 53015)
PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS
Containing: 745 g/L FLUPROPANATE as the only active constituent.

RESTRAINTS:

DO NOT apply product on steeply sloping sites.
DO NOT apply under weather conditions, or from spraying equipment, that may cause drift onto nearby susceptible plants, crops, cropping lands or pastures.
DO NOT spray near desirable trees.

Directions for Use:

Situation	Pest / Disease	Rate
Non-crop areas, rights of way, reserves and bushland.	Running Bamboo species	1 L product/100L

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply by foliar application using knapsack, jet, or power sprayer.
- Apply to the point of runoff.
- Increased efficacy may be achieved by slashing bamboo and treating regrowth when 1m in height.
- Rainfall is required after application to be effective. No activity may be apparent until after rainfall. Application outside of these ideal conditions is expected to be efficacious, however some regrowth may be expected.
- DO NOT allow the herbicide to enter waterways when spraying, either directly or indirectly through spray drift or run-off
- Exclude stock from treated areas. If stock inadvertently access treated areas, refer to product label for withholding periods.

Jurisdiction:

NSW only.

Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.
