## CONDITIONS OF USE

### Products to be used:

COSMOS INSECTICIDAL SEED TREATMENT (APVMA No. 49434)  
PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS  
Containing: 500 g/L FIPRONIL as the only active constituent.

### Restrains:

DO NOT feed treated seed to livestock.  
DO NOT deliver treated seed for processing.  
DO NOT allow treated seed to contaminate grain/other seed intended for animal or human consumption.  
DO NOT feed treated seed, or otherwise expose, to wild or domestic birds.

### Directions for Use:

Crop Type	Pest	Rate
SOYBEAN (Seed treatment as per label)	Lucerne Crown Borer ( <i>Zygrita diva</i> )	200 mL product / 100 kg of seed

### Critical Use Comments:

- Apply one (1) application only as seed treatment within 24 hours prior to sowing.
- Ensure insecticide product is mixed with sufficient water to achieve thorough coverage of seed via calibrated seed coating equipment (refer product label).
- Treated seed should be allowed to dry before re-handling.

### Withholding Period:

Harvest: Not required when used as per label.  
Grazing: DO NOT graze for 9 WEEKS after treatment.

### Jurisdiction:

NSW and QLD only.

### Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.

The holder of the permit must notify the APVMA of new information, including relevant information in accordance with section 161 of the Schedule to the Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994, in accordance with the obligation imposed by that section.

### Other Matters:

Continued issuance of this permit is subject to the outcomes of the current APVMA review of fipronil. This permit may be impacted by the outcomes of this review.
