



**PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF A REGISTERED AGVET CHEMICAL  
PRODUCT FOR CONTROL OF CORAL TREES  
IN NATIVE VEGETATION AND PASTURE**

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

## CONDITIONS OF USE

### Products to be used:

CONQUEROR HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 57783)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 300 g/L TRICLOPYR present as THE BUTOXYETHYL ESTER and 100 g/L PICLORAM present as THE HEXYLOXYPROPYLAMINE SALT as the only active constituents.

GRAZON EXTRA HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 60830)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 300 g/L TRICLOPYR present as THE BUTOXYETHYL ESTER, 100 g/L PICLORAM present as THE HEXYLOXYPROPYLAMINE SALT and 8 g/L AMINOPYRALID present as HEXYLOXYPROPYLAMINE SALT as the only active constituents.

### RESTRAINTS:

DO NOT use product within 5m of waterways.

DO NOT spray if rain is likely within one hour or if foliage is wet from rain or dew.

Comply with all other restraints on the product label.

### Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
Native vegetation and pasture	Coral Trees ( <i>Erythrina</i> spp.)	500 mL / 100L water

### Critical Use Comments:

- Apply from October to May by foliar application using knapsack or handgun.
- Add surfactant as per the product label.
- Apply to plants less than 4 metres tall. When using knapsack, do not treat trees above 1.5 metres tall.
- Apply a maximum two (2) applications per year, with a minimum re-treatment interval of 120 days.
- Make repeat applications according to rate of weed regrowth and re-infestation. For re-treatment, spray re-shooting cut limbs.
- DO NOT apply more than 2 applications per year.
- DO NOT apply less than 120 days after the previous treatment.
- When preparing and using spray, wear cotton overalls buttoned to the neck and wrists, a washable hat, elbow-length PVC gloves and a face shield or goggles. After each day's use, wash gloves, face shield or goggles and contaminated clothing.
- DO NOT allow stock access to treated areas. If stock inadvertently graze treated areas, refer to label for trade advice.
- Comply with '*Protection of crops, native and other non-target plants*' conditions on the product label.

### Withholding Periods:

Cutting or grazing pasture for stock food: Not required when used as directed.

### Jurisdiction:

Mid North Coast, Northern Rivers and Far North Coast of NSW only.

**Protection of Livestock:**

Poisonous plants may become more palatable after spraying and stock should be kept away from these plants until they have died down. Many plants remain poisonous after death, and stock should not be allowed access, as there is a likelihood that they may graze the dead material. Such material should be burnt if possible.

**Additional Conditions:**

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.

The holder of the permit must notify the APVMA of new information, including relevant information in accordance with section 161 of the Schedule to the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994*, in accordance with the obligation imposed by that section.
