

PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF A REGISTERED AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT FOR CONTROL OF OX-EYE DAISY IN TERRESTRIAL SITUATIONS AND SPECIFIED AQUATIC SITUATIONS

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. Products to be used:

MACSPRED METMAC 600 HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 52735)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 600 g/kg METSULFURON METHYL as the only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
Terrestrial situations including in pasture and spraying of pest weed beside waterways (ie creeks and riverbanks and beside wet/boggy areas), drains and margins of aquatic areas	Ox-eye Daisy (Leucanthemum vulgare)	10 g/100 L

Critical Use Comments:

- ONLY apply to actively growing weeds as a spot spray using hand directed sprays from vehicles, quadbikes or knapsacks.
- DO NOT apply spray treatment to ox-eye daisy within 400 m of potable water.
- DO NOT broadcast spray over water or allow spray to drift onto non-target areas.
- DO NOT apply more than 2 applications per growing season with a minimum retreatment interval of 2 months between sprays.
- DO NOT use water from treated areas for irrigation.
- DO NOT spray if rainfall or elevated water flows are expected within 4 hours of application.
- Spray from a point easily accessible to the target ox-eye daisy occurrence and minimise overspray onto vegetation and/or water near the target weed.
- Cease spraying before the herbicide droplets on the leaves begin to coalesce and run-off.
- Only use non-ionic, alcohol or alcohol alkoxylate adjuvants (surfactants) that are not toxic to aquatic life.
- Daisy control around threatened flora or endangered ecological communities should be undertaken by manual removal of the target weed.
- Agitate spray mix constantly during spraying.
- Adhere with any Restraints listed under Directions for Use on the product label.

Jurisdiction:

NSW only.

Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.
