CONDITIONS OF USE

Products to be used:

APRON XL 350 ES FUNGICIDE SEED TREATMENT (APVMA No. 50195) PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 350 g/L METALAXYL-M as the only active constituent.

RESTRAINT:

DO NOT supply treated seed for the Australian sowing seed market.

Directions for Use:

| Seed treatment of seed for sowing for export market of Sunflower (Helianthus annuus) | Sunflower downy mildew (Plasmopara halstedii) | 150-300 mL/100 kg seed |
| Seed treatment of seed for sowing for export market of Sorghum (Sorghum sp.) | Sorghum downy mildew (Peronosclerospora sorghi) | 100 mL/100 kg seed |

Critical Use Comments:

- Treat seed immediately prior to bagging for export.
- Apply using specialised, calibrated batch treating equipment.
- DO NOT apply more than 1 treatment per batch.
- When treated seed stored it should be kept apart from other grain and the bags or other containers should be clearly marked to indicate the contents have been treated.
- All seed packages must be labelled with the following warning: CAUTION: TREATED SEED FOR EXPORT ONLY. TREATED SEED IS NOT TO BE USED FOR FOOD, FEED OR OIL PURPOSES. TREATED SEED IS NOT TO BE SOWN IN AUSTRALIA.
