

PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF A REGISTERED AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT FOR SUPPRESSION OF BROME GRASS IN METRIBUZIN-TOLERANT VARIETIES OF NARROW-LEAF LUPINS

CONDITIONS OF USE

Products to be used:

SENCOR 480 SC SELECTIVE HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 31791) PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 480 g/L METRIBUZIN as the only active constituent.

TITAN METRIBUZIN 750 WG HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 62150) PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 750 g/kg METRIBUZIN as the only active constituent.

RESTRAINT:

Follow all restraints on the product label.

DO NOT apply to varieties which are not metribuzin-tolerant.

Directions for Use:

Narrow-leaf lupins	Brome Grass	480 g/L product:
Metribuzin-tolerant varieties only, including: Mandelup, PBA Barlock, PBA Jurien	(Bromus rigidus and Bromus diandrus)	310 mL/ha 750 g/kg product:
and PBA Leeman	(Suppression only)	200 g/ha

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply pre-emergent only to bare ground in yellow sandplain soil.
- Apply by boom spray using a spray volume of 80-100 L/ha.
- DO NOT apply more than 2 applications per crop.
- DO NOT apply less than 14 days after the initial treatment.
- DO NOT apply post-emergence as crop injury will occur.
- Follow all label Safety Directions, Restraints, Precautions and Protections.

Re-entry: DO NOT re-enter treated areas until spray has dried.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: Not required when used as directed.

Grazing: DO NOT graze or cut for stock food for 14 days after application.

Jurisdiction:

WA only.

Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.

Export of treated produce

Maximum Residue Limits (MRLs) have been established to allow treated produce to be used for human consumption. An MRL has been established for METRIBUZIN in PULSES {EXCEPT SOYA BEAN (DRY)}. MRLs can be found in the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code (MRL Standard) Instrument 2019*. MRLs apply only to produce marketed and consumed in Australia. If treated produce is to be exported, residues must not exceed the limits/tolerances of the importing country.
