## CONDITIONS OF USE

### Products to be used:

LEPIDEX 500 INSECTICIDE (APVMA No. 33110)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 500 g/L TRICHLORFON as the only active constituent.

### Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
Linseed	Rutherglen bug ( <i>Nysius vinitor</i> )	1.1 L/ha

### Critical Use Comments:

- Apply when pests are active.
- Apply by foliar application by boomspray.
- Use a spray volume of 100 L/ha.
- DO NOT apply more than 3 applications per crop.
- DO NOT apply less than 7 days after the initial treatment.
- DO NOT spray any plants in flower while bees are foraging.

### Withholding Period:

Harvest: Do not harvest for 2 days after application.

Grazing: Do not graze or cut for stock food for 2 days after application.

### Jurisdiction:

All States and Territories, except NSW and VIC.

Note: New South Wales and Victoria are not included in this permit, as their Control-of-Use legislation means a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in those States.

### Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.
