PRODUCT FOR QUARANTINE TREATMENT OF NURSERY STOCK (NON-FOOD) TO
CONTROL GREEN SNAIL**

PERMIT NUMBER – PER90760

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows the Permit Holder and any person stipulated below to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Products to be used:

LANNATE-L INSECTICIDE (APVMA No. 47336)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 225 g/L METHOMYL as the only active constituent.

LARVIN 375 INSECTICIDE (APVMA No. 49254)

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 375 g/L THIODICARB as the only active constituent.

RESTRAINT:

DO NOT use in covered or protected situations such as glasshouses, greenhouses or plastic tunnels.

DO NOT apply by hand-held equipment.

Directions for Use:

Situation	Pest	Rate
COMMERCIAL NURSERIES: For Quarantine Treatment of Nursery Stock (non-food producing)	Green Snail <i>(Cantareus apertus)</i>	<u>Methomyl products:</u> 200 mL/100 L Add wetter at 25 mL/100 L Refer to product label. <u>Thiodicarb products:</u> 100 mL/100 L Add wetter at 25 mL/100 L Refer to product label.

Critical Use Comments:

- This permit authorises use in facilities as defined in ICA 25¹.
- Apply in accordance with the ICA 25 operational procedure.
- Apply by ground-based boomspray.
- DO NOT apply more than 1 application per crop.
- DO NOT handle, package or ship treated plants for 24 hours following application. Any manual handling within 24 hours of treatment must be conducted wearing PPE in accordance with the label directions under *Re-entry Period*.
- Adhere to all *Safety Directions* listed on product label.
- Dangerous to bees. DO NOT spray any plants in flower when bees are actively foraging.

Jurisdiction:

WA only – any facility accredited under ICA-25 or under the supervision of a DPIRD Inspector.

Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.

To Avoid Damage to Host Plants

The sensitivity of some species and varieties of plants to be treated under this permit has not been fully evaluated under all growing conditions. It is advisable to treat a small number of plants and closely monitor plant health. Discontinue applications when any adverse symptoms post-treatment are observed.

Efficacy and Domestic Market Access

No determination has been made in regard to the efficacy of this use pattern to meet domestic quarantine and market access requirements as these are determined by each State and Territory. This permit should not be used without first determining that the destination market will accept goods treated in accordance with the use pattern authorised under this permit.
