PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 222 g/L AZOXYSTROBIN and 370 g/L TEBUCONAZOLE as the only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Soya beans	Anthracnose	0.4 L/ha
	(Colletotrichum truncatum)	

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply at first sign of disease when conditions favour disease development.
- Apply by boom spray.
- Use a spray volume of 60 L/ha.
- DO NOT apply more than 2 applications per crop.
- DO NOT apply less than 14 days after the initial treatment.
- The mandatory no-spray zone requirements for winter pulses as directed on the product label must be followed.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: Do not harvest for 28 days after application.

Grazing: Do not graze or cut for stock food for 28 weeks after application.

Jurisdiction:

QLD only.

Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.

To Avoid Crop Damage

The sensitivity of the crop to be treated under this permit has not been fully evaluated. It is advisable to only treat a small area to ascertain the reaction before treating the whole crop.
