This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a user (as indicated) to possess the product for the purposes of use of the product under permit. CONDITIONS OF USE

Products to be used:

CALCIUM NITRATE

AN UNREGISTERED PRODUCT

Containing: 15.5% NITROGEN, 19% CALCIUM and 14.4% total NITRATE as the only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Purpose	Rate
Grape vines used for wine production	Bunch removal	2.5 kg/100 L

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply between E-L 12 (5 leaves separated) and E-L 15 (8 leaves separated) and repeat after 10 days if required.
- Apply by air-blast sprayer.
- Use a spray volume of 200-600 L/ha.
- DO NOT apply more than 2 applications per season.
- DO NOT apply less than 10 days after the initial treatment.
- Use a non-ionic wetter at 60 mL/100 L.
- After use, empty rinse and drain tank. Excess product and rinse water should be discharged onto a designated disposal area, or if this is unavailable, onto unused land away from desirable plants and water resources. Dispose any product packaging at an approved waste management facility.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: Not required when used as directed.

Jurisdiction:

All States and Territories.

Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use the product should wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) which should include appropriate eye protection, overalls buttoned to the neck, wrists and ankles, elbow-length rubber gloves and rubber boots.

Other Matters

The holder of the permit must notify the APVMA of new information, including relevant information in accordance with section 161 of the Schedule to the *Agricultural and Veterinary Chemicals Code Act 1994*, in accordance with the obligation imposed by that section.
