This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows the Permit Holder and any person stipulated below to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Products to be used:

FARMALINX SAYONARA 10 GR HERBICIDE (APVMA No. 89917)

Containing: 10 g/kg PRODIAMINE as the only active constituent.

RESTRAINT:

DO NOT apply to vegetable or herbs seedlings.

DO NOT apply if heavy rains or storms are forecast within 3 days.

DO NOT apply under conditions which will cause granule movement from the treatment area.

DO NOT apply to waterlogged soil.

DO NOT irrigate to the point of runoff from the treated area for at least 3 days after application.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
Nursery Stock (non-food) – seedlings, tubes, plugs, potted colour, trees, shrubs, foliage plants, palms, grasses, fruiting plants (non-bearing), cut flowers and ornamentals (Field and protected cropping situations)	Pre-emergent control of grass and broad leaf weeds (as per Farmalinx Sayonara 10 GR Herbicide label)	50-200 kg/ha or 5-20 g/m ²

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply evenly on the soil surface of pots/ground.
- Apply by hand-held or hand operated granular spreader or shaker.
- If hand-held or hand operated shaker is used the work rate must be limited to 280 square meters per day.
- Continue to monitor crops and make a subsequent application as necessary at 3-4 months later for perennial plants.
- Follow all *Safety Directions* listed on the product label.

PROTECTION OF CROPS, NATIVE AND OTHER NON-TARGET PLANTS

DO NOT apply or drain or flush equipment on or near native or non-target trees or other plants or on areas where their roots may extend or in locations where the chemical may be washed or moved into contact with their roots.

PROTECCION OF WILDLIFE, FISH, CRUSTACEANS AND ENVIRONMENT

Very toxic to aquatic life. DO NOT contaminate wetlands or watercourses with this product or used containers. To protect birds and wild animals, remove spillages.

Jurisdiction:

All States and Territories, except VIC.

Note: Victoria is not included in this permit, as their Control-of-Use legislation means a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in that State.

Additional Conditions:

This permit allows for the use of a product in a manner specified on the permit. Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit. Unless otherwise stated, the use of the product must be in accordance with the product label.

To Avoid Crop Damage

The sensitivity of the crop to be treated under this permit has not been fully evaluated. It is advisable to only treat a small area to ascertain the reaction before treating the whole crop.
